STANDARD OF CONDUCT FOR TCA

Trinity Christian Academy holds that the Bible is the infallible, divine Word of God and that salvation by faith in Christ is the initial step in the Christian life. There is adequate Biblical basis for the idea of spiritual growth into the image of Christ (Romans 8:29), which is the work of the Holy Spirit (2 Corinthians 3:18). This growth begins with the initial act of saving faith and continues throughout life. The Holy Spirit makes the Christian conscious of the Biblical demands for a holy life which fulfills both God's moral law and high law of love (Matthew 22:37-29; Romans 12 8-10; Galatians 15:14). The result is a life consecrated unto God and separated from the world.

Trinity Christian Academy provides an environment conducive to the spiritual growth and development of young people who are maturing Christians. A standard of conduct based on the following Biblical imperatives is necessary to provide such an environment. All of the activities of the Christian must be to the glory of God who indwells us (1 Corinthians 8:9, 12-12, 10:21). The Christian must endeavor to avoid practices which cause the loss of sensitivity of the spiritual needs of the world and loss of the Christian's physical, mental, or spiritual well being (1 Corinthians 9:27).

The need for spiritual growth in the light of these principles has led Trinity Christian Academy to adopt the following standards. The school, therefore, requests each student, whether at home, school, or elsewhere:

1. Refrain from swearing, drugs, indecent language, gambling, dancing, (formal dance classes not included, i.e. tap, ballet, clogging, etc), drinking, disorderly and boisterous behavior, and tobacco use of any kind.
2. Maintain Biblical standards in courtesy, kindness, morality and honesty.
3. Dress modestly and appropriately.
4. Refrain from the use of worldly music such as rock, country and western music that has the theme of sex, drugs, rebellion, unchristian lyrics, or any type of music with unchristian themes.

The selection of the restrictions mentioned in this pledge may appear arbitrary to some. While not condemning others who see differently, TCA believes that the restrictions named are outstanding types of conduct.

Students are expected to abide by the standards throughout their enrollment whether at school or elsewhere. Families found to be out of harmony with Trinity Christian Academy's idea of work and life may be invited to withdraw whenever the general welfare demands it, even though there may be no special breach of conduct.
